ABOUT THE NEW NEIGHBOURHOOD/

The Colchester & Tendring Borders Garden Community is a joint project between Tendring District Council, Colchester City Council and Essex County Council. It is a planned new green community comprising 9,000 homes which will be a sustainable and attractive place to live, work and visit based on Garden Community principles.

It will be a unique community, drawing inspiration from land, sky and water. The intention is that it will be have a dark sky, contributing little or no light pollution so night skies will be perfect for stargazing. Water will be integrated into the new community in meaningful ways, and rural life will be protected and celebrated as much as possible.
